

# Competition Terms & Conditions

1. HUMO are accepting short films of all production techniques: e.g. animation, live action. Only one short film can be submitted by participants.
2. The short film can be co-created and hence co-submitted by more than one person; all submitters must be eligible to compete.
3. Films should not be focused on the promotion of commercial products or services.
4. The total film length should not exceed 7 minutes duration. The film should be no shorter than 3 minutes.
5. The person submitting the film must be authorised to do so and is responsible for ensuring that formal permission and credit is given to all those who have ownership or rights in connection with it.
6. You must be a young person over the age of 16, and under the age of 26, to apply. All people featured in the film's cast must also be over the age of 16, or evidence of parental permission must be provided for those under the age of 16.
7. Third party elements such as music, sound, graphics or still images used within the production should be original and copyright free. If copyrighted content is used, please be prepared to provide evidence of the granted permissions.
8. The content of the film cannot, in the opinion of the HUMO team, be deemed offensive (e.g. racism, sexism and homophobia will not be tolerated). Please also make a clear distinction between facts and perceptions or opinions that you present.
9. If the original language of any dialogue or text featured in the film is not English, the film must be subtitled in English.
10. By sharing any film with HUMO you agree to grant to HUMO, free of charge, a non-exclusive, perpetual, and worldwide licence to re-publish any material you submit, post, upload, email or otherwise transmit for the competition. HUMO have the right to use the material in any way it wants (including modifying and adapting it). This may include presenting your film at events organised by third party organisations. Your work will always be acknowledged as yours and we will always endeavour to confirm your agreement to further screenings of this kind in advance.
11. The deadline for submission is Friday 14<sup>th</sup> May 2021. Film submissions will not be accepted for the competition after this date.
12. All filmmakers whose films are shortlisted will be notified by email or phone.
13. HUMO may provide individual feedback in relation to any submission either before entry or following short-listing or judging, though it is not a guarantee.
14. HUMO will ensure that all personal information provided within the submission form will never be used for anything other than direct contact from the competition. Your information will not be shared with any other organisation or festival without your permission.
